Resolution 3

FILLING VACANCIES OF GENERAL COUNCIL EXECUTIVE OFFICES

1	WHEREAS, The General Council is stronger by allowing more people to be involved in
2	the election process; and
3	WHEREAS, These offices are more than representatives of our Pentecostal Movement,
4	doctrine, and leadership, but they function as authoritative fiduciary offices with
5	governing and corporate responsibilities and powers, accountable to the General
6	Council, the State of Missouri, and the IRS; and
7	WHEREAS, The credibility of these offices is established by divine calling, qualified
8	leadership giftings/skill sets, and spiritual maturity while requiring credible acumen
9	in the arena of corporate functions and operations; and
10	WHEREAS, The custom of this Fellowship is to seek the best and most proficient leaders
11	from across the Fellowship; and
12	WHEREAS, This Fellowship is healthier and more stable when a larger part of the body
13	participates by nominating credible leaders into the executive offices; and
14	WHEREAS, The long-term stability of this Fellowship best occurs when more qualified
15	credentialed ministers have the electoral opportunity to nominate or elect
16	leadership; and
17	WHEREAS, The national leadership pipeline is better when a larger body has the
18	opportunity to identify and express confidence in emerging or existing leaders
19	through the nomination and/or election process; therefore, be it
20	RESOLVED, that the General Council Bylaws, ARTICLE II. ELECTION OF
21	OFFICERS AND PRESBYTERS, Section 3. Vacancies, paragraph a. Executive
22	Officers, page 28, which reads:
23	a. Executive officers. In the event any of the executive offices
24	of The General Council of the Assemblies of God shall become
25	vacant through death or other cause, the Executive Presbytery shall
26	fill the office by appointment until the next meeting of the General
27	Council; with the exception that, in the event of a vacancy in the office
28	of general superintendent for any reason, the assistant general
29	superintendent shall succeed to the office of general superintendent

until the next General Council; or, in the event the offices of general superintendent and assistant general superintendent both become vacant, the succession to the office of general superintendent until the next General Council shall be as follows: first, the general secretary, and second, the general treasurer.

Be amended to read:

- a. Executive officers. In the event any of the executive offices of The General Council of the Assemblies of God shall become vacant through death or other cause, the General Executive Presbytery shall fill the office by election appointment until the next meeting of the General Council; with the exception that, in the event of a vacancy in the office of general superintendent for any reason, the assistant general superintendent shall succeed to the office of general superintendent until the next General Council; or, in the event the offices of general superintendent and assistant general superintendent both become vacant, the succession to the office of general superintendent until the next General Council shall be as follows: first, the general secretary, and second, the general treasurer. An executive officer fulfilling an unexpired term of less than one year will have the term extended to include a full term, while an executive officer fulfilling an unexpired term of one or more years will be up for reelection at the next General Council.
 - (1) For the offices of general superintendent and assistant superintendent, nominations shall be received from the General Council authorized voting constituency.
 - (2) For the offices of general secretary, general treasurer, executive director of U.S. Missions, and executive director of World Missions, nominations shall be received from the General Presbytery. Should three names not receive a minimum of 10 percent of the votes cast, the General Presbytery shall consider no fewer than the top three vote recipients.
