Check the calendar regularly and block out unavailable dates.</p> <p><b>Confirmations:</b> Respond to scheduling confirmations within ____ days. If you cannot serve, provide a reason when rejecting an event.</p> <p><b>Emergency Cancellations:</b> If you need to cancel or modify your schedule due to an emergency, contact your team leader immediately, or if needed, the Worship Leader.</p> <p><b>Participating in Services:</b> Attend the full service you are leading worship for. After serving, stay to receive the word, engage with the congregation and experience the service.</p>

# Accountability and Discipline

**Accountability:** We are called to hold each other accountable in love, supporting one another in our spiritual growth and ministry.

**Moral Failure:** If a moral failure occurs, there will be an initial meeting with the Worship Leader to discuss steps for restoration, including a probationary period.

**Sabbaticals:** If a break is needed from serving, after allowing enough time, schedule a meeting with the Worship Leader.

No holes above the knees on jeans.</li><li>3. No cleavage showing.</li><li>4. No hats or caps.</li><li>5. Skirts and dresses need to be to the knees.</li></ol>	<p>Be as prepared as you can be so that there is freedom in your worship on the altar.</p>
